NOTICE TO CLERKS

Pursuant to Section 125.1506 of the Stille-DeRossett-Hale Single State Construction Code, 1972 PA 230, attached is a copy of the promulgated rules for the 2015 Michigan Residential Code and Part 10 Residential Energy Code. These rules adopt the 2015 edition of the International Residential Code with amendments, deletions and additions deemed necessary for use in Michigan, and are effective statewide on February 8, 2016. Upon the effective date, every unit of government with building code administration and enforcement responsibility must enforce the new rules.

PLEASE NOTE:

The rules provided in this packet are only those rules affected during the recent Michigan amendment process. Michigan also adopts by reference rules from the International Residential Code. **The Part 10 Residential Energy Code will be printed as chapter 11 of the 2015 Michigan Residential Code.**

It is the responsibility of the code-enforcing agency to assure the **complete** Michigan Residential Code is purchased for use by inspection staff and a copy of each is available for inspection by the public.

The bureau has coordinated the sale of the 2015 Michigan Residential Code with the International Code Council (ICC). A web link will be added to the bureau's web site at www.michigan.gov/bcc, in November to allow customers to purchase the code book(s) directly from ICC at the Michigan code book price of \$118.00. It is anticipated books will be available for purchase by late-November. The Michigan amendments to the code may be downloaded for free from the bureau's web site at www.michigan.gov/bcc.
